For example, the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) recently added foreign-made drones to its "Covered List," preventing new products from many consumer and enterprise drone manufacturers, including the two largest, from entering the U.S. market. And now, the FCC has initiated a proceeding that could ban future imports of several drones that are currently available - including drones with thermal imaging capabilities, LiDAR sensing, agricultural spray drones, and others that are widely used across America today by hobbyists, small businesses, farmers, and public safety agencies.

This would be devastating to our industry, but the DAA has made it easy for you to share your story with the FCC, ensuring that they know how their actions could impact you and those like you.
